CONDITIONAL TYPE 1

Instead of *will*, we can use **modal verbs**, such as *can, must, may, might, should*, etc. **in the main clause** to express ability, permission, necessity, possibility, advice, etc.

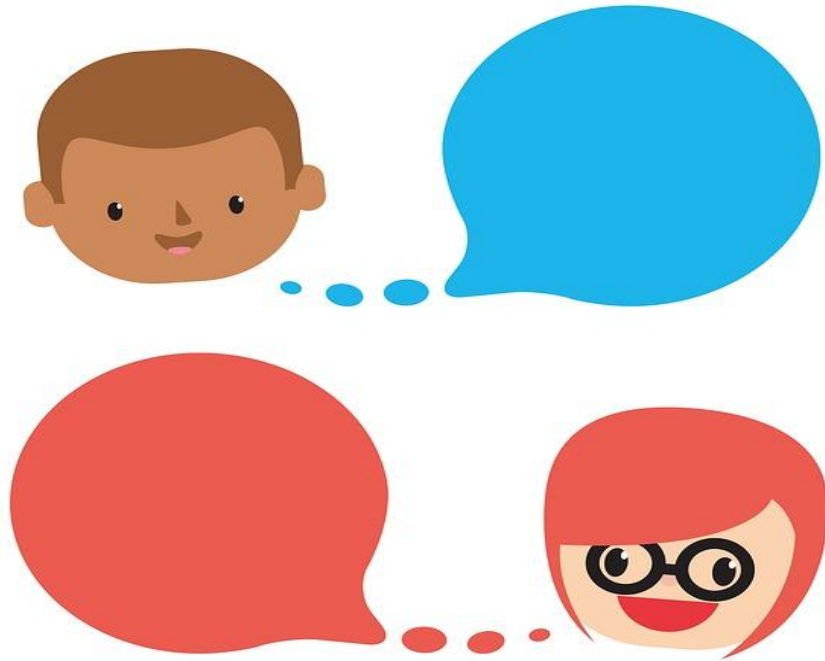

	S +	possibility
	S +	necessity

IF - CLAUSE	MAIN CLAUSE	
S + V (present simple) + O,	S + will + V ...,	standard form
	S + can + V...,	Ability/ permission
	S + should + V...,	advice
	S + may/might + V...,	possibility
	S + must + V...,	necessity

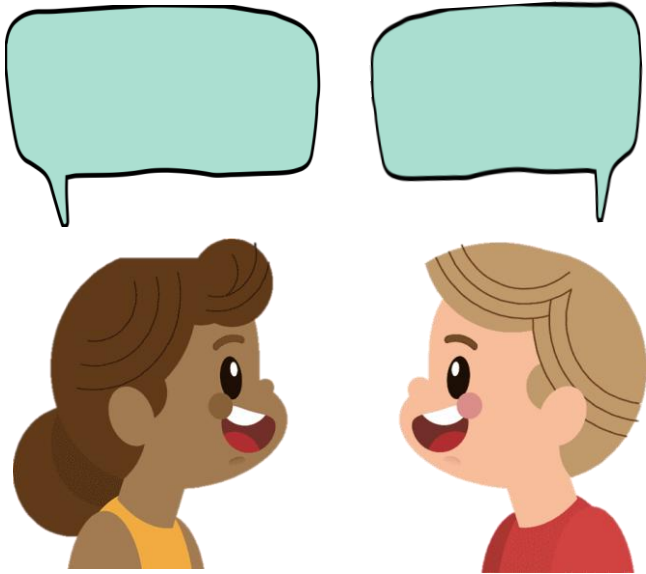
